MONITOR



Monitor air pollution. Transportation and wood smoke are the two largest sources of air pollution in our area. We also study what is in the air we breathe and share what we know and learn.

REGULATE



Prevent, reduce, and control air pollution emissions and exposure to the public by using a combination of regulations, conditional permits, enforcement, compliance assistance, and education.

ENGAGE



Protect, educate, and include those who are disproportionately affected by air pollution.

BURN BANS



Issue burn bans according to state criteria when wood smoke or smoke from wildfires is anticipated to reach levels that will impact our health.

PARTNER



Build partnerships with our communities, local businesses, and governments to help them adopt strategies and technologies that reduce emissions and air pollution.

CLIMATE CHANGE



Work against climate change by offering programs for cleaner fuels, vehicles, and transportation choices.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Our Board of Directors represents you. The Board is made up of elected officials from each of our four counties, representatives from the largest city in each county, and a member for the Public-at-Large.

ADVISORY COUNCIL

Our Advisory Council provides guidance and input on agency programs and regulations. The Advisory Council is made up of representatives of large and small businesses, suburban cities, area sources, education, transportation, health, tribal nations, fire chiefs, environmental justice, local ports, the environmental community, and the Public-at-Large.
