

## NSPS Subpart Dc Semi-Annual Report Form for Fuel Oil-Fired Boilers

Boilers which are manufactured after June 9, 1989, with a maximum design heat input capacity of 100 MMBtu/hr or less, but greater than or equal to 10 MMBtu/hr, are subject to Standards of Performance for Small Industrial-Commercial Institutional Steam Generating Units, 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart Dc (Subpart Dc).

Boilers which are subject to Subpart Dc and which are capable of firing oil are required to submit semi-annual reports. This includes the capability to use oil as a backup even if not recently fired on oil. Reports must be e-mailed or postmarked by the 30th day following the end of the reporting period. For example, reports must be postmarked by July 30 for January 1 – June 30 reporting period and reports must be postmarked by January 30 for July 1 – December 31 reporting period.<sup>1</sup>
