Primary and Secondary Wastewater Treatment with the following source groups: A. Combustion (a new 25.7 MMBH boiler #3, and two John Zink Flares (#1 at 2,000 cfm & #2 at 500 scfm); B. Solids (three scrubbers at 75,000 cfm each to control odors from the raw sludge blending tank, polymer room, ten gravity belt thickeners, truck loading & four sludge centrifuges; 2-sludge tanks with 2-225 cfm adsorbers; & 2-4,000 cfm adsorbers for 6-digesters); and C. Liquids (Primary Treatment sources with 3-odor control scrubbers at 75,000 cfm each and a prescrubber at 3,200 cfm; & Secondary Treatment sources at 143 MGD annual average with an emergency release chlorine scrubber at 35,000 cfm).
