You must meet all the listed criteria in order to use this Temporary Boiler General Order form; if the proposed boiler falls outside of the listed parameters, please use the [Notice of Construction and Application for Approval \(Form P\)](#) and the [Boiler and Process Heater supplemental form](#) to apply for a case-by-case Notice of Construction application review. Natural gas-fired boilers rated at less than 10 MMBtu/hr are exempt from the requirement to obtain an order of approval.

-The one-hour average exhaust concentration of nitrogen oxides (NOx) shall not exceed 30 parts per million by volume, dry (ppmvd), corrected to 3% O<sub>2</sub>.

- The one-hour average exhaust concentration of carbon monoxide (CO) shall not exceed 50 parts per million by volume, dry (ppmvd), corrected to 3% O<sub>2</sub>.

How will you demonstrate compliance with these limits? (Choose one.)

A written guarantee from the boiler manufacturer.

Portable gas analyzer measurements (ASTM D6522-00, ANSI/ASME PTC 19.10-1981, EPA CTM-030, EPA CTM-034, or other Agency-approved methods) will be conducted within 30 days of startup of the temporary boiler.

If the permanent boiler is equipped with selective non-catalytic reduction, selective catalytic reduction, or an oxidation catalyst, will the temporary boiler be equipped with the same add-on pollution control device?

Not applicable. The permanent boiler does not have any of these add-on pollution controls.

Yes, the temporary boiler will be equipped with the same controls as the permanent boiler.
